Married Joyce Bissall 17 Nov. 1665
Removed to Simsbury 1667-1669; Left there after burning
of Town 1676. Was afterwards employed in surveying of
Ellington where he settled.

Benjamin⁶, eldest son of Eleazen (and Eunice King) was born in Ellington 4 July 1780 mrd. Susannah McKinney, of Ellington by whom he had 10 children: William, Persis; Pamela; Benjamin; Albert; Henry; Samuel; Emily; Elizabeth; Susan He died 12 July 1860 Wife d. 10 July, 1868. Held many local offices-J.P. Rept.

Samuel B. Pinney⁷ (printed as Belcher according to John) son of Benjamin & Susannah McKinney Pinney Lived in Ellington all his life 1822 (5 Oct 1820 per Allen Gen.)

He mrd. 17 March 1842 Nancy, dau of the late Hezekiah Allen of East Windsor. They soon moved to Bloomfield where they now (1899) reside. Mr. Pinney is a farmer And a prominent citizen of Bloomfield. (from Allen Gen. He died in Bloomfield 8 Oct 1893 Wife died Bloomfield 12 March 1892
