2 HIKES IN BLOOMFIELD WITH THE WINTONBURY LAND TRUST

SATURDAY, JUNE 6TH 9:30AM - NOON STOUT FAMILY FIELDS TO THE PINNACLE IN PENWOOD STATE PARK

This hike will start at the Wintonbury Land Trust's Stout Family Fields property on Stone Hill Road in Bloomfield. There will be two options: one that is more chal-lenging and one that is less challenging. The group will decide while on the hike. After experiencing the gorgeous views from the Pinnacle, we will make our way back to the Stout Family Field. The total distance of the hike will be approximately between two and three miles, depending upon the route.

SATURDAY, JUNE 6TH - 2:00 PM - 3:00 PM VAN OTTERLOO TRAIL - WATERFALL

This hike will start at B'nai Tikvoh-Sholom at 180 Still Road in Bloomfield. Beginning at the stone wall, we will follow the trail through thick under brush to reach a waterfall located under a large conifer canopy and then follow the stream until turns east and loops back to the start. The total distance of the hike is approximately one mile.
